# HELP FOR THOUSANDS OF RIDERS

## Grants for educational events are awarded across the country

Some of TDF's most popular Grant Funds are for educational events. TDFfunded clinics, camps, seminars, and symposia are held in many states every year. These events help riders from Introductory Level to Grand Prix, of all ages, and riding all breeds of horses.

In 2022, for the first time ever, TDF awarded a grant for a dressage clinic in Puerto Rico! With the help of a grant from TDF's Michael Poulin Fund, Hacienda Siesta Alegre Equestrian Center was able to host a weekend clinic for riders interested in learning more about dressage.

Fourteen riders from across Puerto Rico took part in the clinic, including Western riders, Paso Fino riders, and jumpers. Clinic organizer Cindy Bozek said that "elation" was the best way to describe the feelings of the riders after the clinic. She said, "There were many smiles, and many 'dressage dots' connected!"


